## Emergency Food Delivery Assistance

If you are unable to get to a Pantry, temporary emergency food delivery is available.

Individuals/households must meet the following guidelines:

- Meets low income guidelines (BHA resident, receive SNAP/SSI/Medicare/Medicaid, or have received previous home delivery (Meals on Wheels, etc.))
- Disabled or High Risk due to age, compromised immune system, or other medical condition
- Lives in Brookline
- Referred from a local social service agency (optional)

## Grab & Go School Meals

Students who qualify for free or reduced school meals can pick up free “Grab ‘n Go” prepared meals. Each student may order 2 days’ worth of meals, which provide 2 breakfasts and 2 lunches.
